Pre-Kindergarten through Graduate Studies*

Dates for Honor Roll Recognition

- Certificates will be awarded based on quarter grades.
- Certificates will be awarded twice a year.
- First submission dates for grades will be January 2, 2012 – January 29, 2012.
- Recognition date for 1st and 2nd quarter grades will be Sunday, February 19, 2012.
- Second submission dates for grades will be May 27, 2012 - June 17, 2012.
- Recognition date for 3rd and 4th quarter grades will be Sunday, June 24, 2012.

***For each grade level, please submit a copy of the report card to the church office or in the collection tin.
***Allowances will be made for school districts or schools with alternate grading systems

Honor Roll Criterion for Pre-K/Preschool

- Certificates will be awarded for promotion to Kindergarten.
- Submit copy of report card to church office or Education Council collection box.
- Students without a report card, parents/guardians must provide an official school document validating promotion.

**Pre-K/Preschool will be recognized only at 3rd and 4th quarter honor roll recognition.*

Honor Roll Criterion for Kindergarten – Fourth Grade

- Minimum 3.0 GPA.
- **Levels of Performance/Achievement** marks will be evaluated.
- GPA will be computed based on Levels of Performance/Achievement .
- To arrive at GPA, earned points will be used.
- Earned points for Level of Performance/Achievement classes will be added and divided by the number of Level of Performance/Achievement classes.

Honor Roll Criterion for Fifth Grade - Twelfth Grade (GPA BASED)

- Minimum 3.0 GPA. (B-Average)
- **Level of Achievement** marks will be evaluated.
- GPA will be computed based on Levels of Achievement
- To arrive at GPA, earned points will be used.
- Earned points for Level of Achievement classes will be added and divided by the number of Level of Achievement classes.
- Honors and Advanced Placement Courses will be evaluated one full grade above regular performance marks.
