As we commemorate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior this **Resurrection Sunday, April 4**, let us remain grateful for the sacrifice He made for us, laying down his life as payment for our sins that we might have eternal life. Please remember to pick up your communion elements from church **Saturday, April 3**, between **10 a.m. to 2 p.m.** Pickup will take place on the South side of the building (daycare side). Please follow directions from the parking lot attendants.

On Sunday, April 4, we will commune together during parking lot worship service. We will host two services—**10 a.m. and noon**. Participants should enter the church parking lot from the 33rd Street entrance, park in an available stall and tune into worship through our normal virtual worship channels. Following services, cars should exit through the JC Wade Boulevard entrance. To maintain social distancing, please be aware that the church building will not be accessible during the worship experience. We ask that you cooperate with our security team and church volunteers who will assist in the parking lot during the service. We look forward to worshipping with you.

Water damage repairs on-track inside the church

Repairs inside the church are on-track. Our updated return timeframe is end of March/early April. Within the past month, the lighting system in the sanctuary and foyer were upgraded and all LED lights have been installed. All drywall has been repaired, replaced and painted. Damaged baseboard and electrical outlets have also been replaced.

Later this month, the heater in the breezeway will be replaced and tilework near the History Wall will be replaced. The vendor has also been working to restore the pew supports—legs and stands. Once that work is

complete, a deep cleaning of the carpeted areas and stone flooring in the breezeway and near the pulpit will take place.
